TUITION FEES-2023

Dunwoody Christian Academy has been serving families by providing childcare for 17 years now. We are grateful for the opportunity you've granted us to care for your children and are always striving to operate professionally while maintaining our facility at the highest level. As a licensed Bright From the Start provider, we're focused on making sure the attention, care and instruction your child receives is the best possible. In January there will be an increase in tuition. The new rates will enable us to continue to provide exceptional care for your children and invest in the overall quality of the programs we offer while also keeping up with current inflation rates. The current national inflation rate is between 7.7% to 8.2%. While we want to make sure we are able to keep up with inflation rates with what me must spend to successfully run Dunwoody Christian Academy, we also understand the hardship of an increase of 7+%. Our current rate will be increasing by 5% and we will re-assess our rates and the current inflation rate over the summer of 2023. Thank you for your trust and support. We certainly value our relationship and consider it an honor to have your children in our care. Below are the updated tuition rates for 2023 . PARENT REMINDERS:

If you are dropping your child off to school after 9:30am, please let your child's teacher or the front office know. Dropping off after 9:30am without knowledge really disrupts the flow of the day. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.

During the winter months, please make sure your child**wears/brings a coat to school.** Our students must have coats to go outside and our classes are required to go outside unless it is raining.

If your child is diagnosed with a**contagious illness,** please let the front desk know as we need to communicate those to the classrooms.

Outside food and beverage is not allowed at the school without a written doctors note (exceptions: young infants, students who do not drink cows milk may have their own milk (labeled in the kitchen)). Treats for birthday parties should be store bought and peanut free. Students should NOT come to school eating outside breakfast.

DCA Kindergarten Students: **Please remember to sign up for Holiday Camps with DCA Kindergarten is closed**. Although camp is free to you, we must know who is attending so that we can successfully staff, plan for and pay for field trips and order meals.

Tuition is due in a timely manner. We do not charge late payment fees until the middle of the month, however; tuition is due by the 3rd unless you have a payment arrangement on file (i.e. paying weekly, bi-weekly, on certain days of the month etc.). Families who are a month or more behind in tuition risk disenrollment.
